Paul Manz enriched the world of sacred music in a wide variety of ways.

Organist, teacher, composer, lecturer, conductor, scholar and undoubted enthusiast. He was an inspirational guide for generations of aspiring musicians, and his enthusiastic advocacy of hymnody did much to nurture and develop this most ancient of traditions.

Manz, a Bach enthusiast,

proved a persuasive interpreter of his own music as an organ recitalist. A splendidly natural technique provided him with a perfect platform to entertain, be it amid the vastness of the Kennedy Center in Washington D.C. or the intimacy of a small country church.
