He has been playing accordion since he was 7 years old, beginning in the 50's and 60's and establishing his career as a club entertainer at many Twin Cities clubs. In 1963 he had his own television show "Polka Jamboree" on WTCN, now named KARE 11, airing on Sunday nights. The show was popular, rating second only to "Lassie" and lasted two seasons. Tony also owned the Bel Rae Ballroom in Mounds View for 25 years.
